

Origami Kusudama Flowers

ORIGAMI KUSUDAMA FLOWERS.



The Kusudama flower is made of several identically folded sections (normally 5 or 6) that are glued together to make a flower. You can use any sort of crisp paper such as magazines, wrapping or printing paper you have decorated yourself. This is then cut into 5 or 6 squares. The smallest I have found success with are 4cm square. The larger the square the bigger the petal and the more dramatic the outcome is. When completed you can embellish the centre with buttons, thread or even pompoms!! You can thread fine wire through the middle to help you attach it or use fine wire or barbeque skewers to allow you to arrange them in a vase.
