Repton Community Group Covid 19 - Information for isolated persons (IP)

If you need **any** help (shopping, prescriptions, a phone call), in the first instance, please contact the name of the person on the piece of paper or postcard that came through your door. Please bear in mind that the personnel detailed above may well change as the weeks go by due to the virus.

If you have any ideas, please contact the Action Team Member for your area – or get on and action it yourself, so long as you are following Government Guidelines regarding Covid 19.

WE WILL

- pass your personal data to the Emergency Services if required
- keep your personal data as accurate and up to date as possible in order to help with what you need
- destroy any data we hold on you as soon as it is no longer needed
- share your personal data with the volunteers covering your cluster area
- only use your personal data and information for the purposes of helping support you through this time
- keep your personal data safe and secure

WE WON'T

- share your data unless required to in order to help you and keep you safe
- post any data which can identify you on social media
- take any actions that put you or your privacy at risk

ISOLATED PERSON - Do's & Don'ts

DO

- DO keep the receipt (mark it paid and then take a photo of it for records)
- DO wash your hands and wipe your shopping with disinfectant.

DON'T

- DON'T give your bank details / PIN numbers or cards to your volunteer
